OVERVIEW

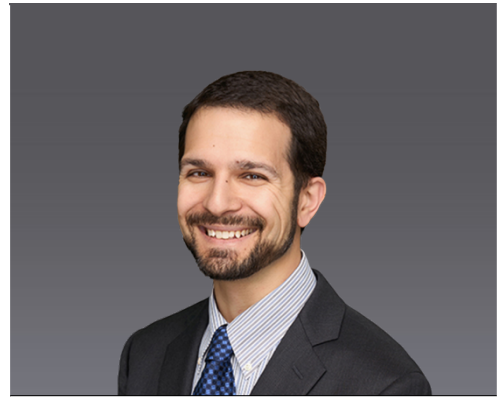
